



**NOTICE TO THE CREDITORS OF THE COMPANY  
INVITATION TO LODGE A CLAIM**

The undersigned Mr. Maurizio Civardi, Extrordinary Administrator of the company indicated below,

**WHEREAS**

The Court of Asti declared the state of insolvency of AGES S.p.A. by judgment dated December 1st , 2008 (A.S. no 2/08, chron. 1669), and proceeded to appoint the Delegated Judge (giudice delegato), Mrs Patrizia Dolcino, and fix the hearing dates for the examination of liabilities on March 26th, 2009 at 10 o'clock a.m. and to set for creditors and holders of real and personal titles on movable and immovable assets owned by, or in possession of, the company, deadline for filing applications to be admitted to the statement of liabilities (domande di ammissione al passivo) on March 3rd , 2009.

**COMMUNICATES**

to creditors and to holders of real and personal titles on movable and immovable assets owned by, or in possession of, the company AGES S.p.A. , that they can participate in the proceeding by filing their applications to be admitted to the statement of liabilities, at the office of the Clerk of the Court of Asti, Via Govone 5, 14100 Asti, 2nd floor, within March 3rd, 2009.

Applications for admission to the statement of liabilities, for claim or restitution, should be filed though a petition , which can be signed also personally by the party, containing the information specified by article 93 Royal Decree dated 16 March 1942, no 267, and as such the following information should be included: first name and family name of the creditor, tax code, VAT code (when applicable), elected domicile in Asti, the total amount claimed, the title to the credit and any priority rights, or the description of the assets for which restitution or claim is made.

Applications must be accompanied by the appropriate documentation (regarding title to the credit, priority rights and restitution claims).

Creditors must file their applications and related documentation in two copies.

In the event of failure to elect domicile in Asti, all notifications will be made at the office of the Clerk of the Court of Asti. Asti, December 2008.
